

**Statement by a resident of a student dormitory at UWr**

*Bearing in mind the safety and health protection, as well as minimizing the risk of infection with SARS-CoV-2 virus to the residents and staff of student dormitories, in compliance with the guidelines of the Minister Education and Science developed in consultation with the Chief Sanitary Inspector, concerning the provision of safe accommodation conditions in student dormitories during the COVID-19 epidemic, please make the following statements.*

**I declare as follows:**

1. I do not have any worrisome symptoms of infectious respiratory illness suggestive of coronavirus infection (specifically: fever, cough, shortness of breath), and if I do, I agree to immediately inform the dormitory manager (by phone or email) in order to:

- a) identify the area in which I moved and stayed and to make a list of persons (if possible) present at the same time in the part(s) of the building where I stayed;
- b) advise that they obtain a consultation by a primary care physician as soon as possible.

2. While accommodated in a student dormitory I undertake to observe strictly the rules of safety and personal hygiene introduced by the Chief Sanitary Inspector, in particular: to disinfect my hands before entering the facilities, to observe the rules of social distance, and in particular to avoid gathering, to cover my mouth and nose (with a mask), to inform immediately the staff of the administration of the student dormitory (by phone or e-mail) of any suspicion arising from my contact with a person infected with COVID-19.

**At the same time, I declare that I am aware of the risks and consequences related to staying at a dormitory during COVID-19 epidemic. I am aware that failure to observe the sanitary requirements and information obligations indicated above may also lead to criminal liability as referred to in Article 116 § 1 of the Misdemeanours Code and Article 161 § 2-3 of the Penal Code.**

**Information concerning the processing of so-called regular and sensitive personal data of residents at student dormitories during the COVID-19 epidemic**

**2. Purposes of processing and legal basis for processing:** The legal basis for processing your personal data is based on Article 6 item 1 d), e) and Article 9 (2) (i) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation):

- to perform a task carried out in the public interest; to protect the life and health of the data subject or another natural person, in order to ensure safe and hygienic conditions of accommodation in student residences, during the Covid-19 epidemic (Article 11(5); 50(1), 51(1) of the Law on Higher Education and Science

*The provision of personal data (first and last name, chosen means of direct communication: e-mail address or telephone number, room number, date of arrival, data about occurring medical symptoms) is voluntary, but necessary to ensure safety and health protection, as well as to minimize the risk of COVID-19 infection. If this information is not provided, accommodation in student dormitories will not be possible.*

**3. Period of retention of personal data:** We will retain your personal data (provided in the declaration submitted above) for the duration of your residence in a student dormitory, which will be deleted no later than one month from the date of dislodging.

**4. Recipients of data:** We may share your personal data with public authorities or entities entitled to obtain the data on the basis of applicable legislation, in particular sanitary units carrying out tasks aimed at preventing, counteracting and combating COVID-19.

**5. Rights related to the processing of personal data:** You have the following rights:

- 1) the right of access to your personal data;
- 2) the right to request rectification of your personal data that is inaccurate and completion of incomplete personal data;
- 3) the right to demand erasure of your personal data. This right does not apply in particular to the extent that the processing is necessary: for the performance of a task carried out in the interest of the general public; for reasons of public interest in the field of public health, such as protection against serious cross-border threats to health, if this is provided by law;
- 4) the right to request restriction of the processing of your personal data;
- 5) the right to object to the processing of your personal data, where the basis for the processing is the performance of a task carried out in the public interest, unless the University demonstrates that there are valid legitimate grounds for the processing which override the interests, rights and freedoms of the data subject;
- 6) the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority dealing with personal data protection, i.e. the President of the Office for Personal Data Protection.
- 7) Your personal data shall not be subject to automated decision-making, including profiling.
